

Covid-19 Risk Assessment

Summary Statement

All activities will be carried out in line with current government Covid-19 guidelines and are continually reviewed. This risk assessment must be read in conjunction with all other activity and site-specific risk assessments.

Risk/Hazard	Level of Risk	Current Precautions or Measures	Potential Further Action
Visitor parking	Low	Provide unrestricted parking to staff and visitors in the stadium footprint which offers adequate space for all vehicles to be parked at safe distances apart.	If visitor numbers increase, consider parking signage.
Visitor queues outside arranged meeting point	Low	Visitor numbers are restricted to maximum two every 10-minute period with allocated time slots for arrival.	If visitor numbers increase, consider signage and/or social distancing markings at designated meeting point.
Ticket handling	Medium	All visitors will be required to show proof of booking as condition of entry, however there will be no handling of paper (or other) tickets by members of staff.	
Contact with stadium external doors/gates/handles	Medium	One single entry gate will be used, and one member of staff only will operate this gate. Visitors/public will not touch any gates or handles. Gate handles to be sanitised before and after each event.	Consider signage on the entry gate.
Walkways and concourse safety	Low	All visitors will be escorted to the designated 'Open Spaces' zone in the stadium by a single member of staff, ensuring social distancing is observed. Walkways and concourses will be cleared of obstructions and visitors will be instructed not to touch any surfaces, fences, barriers, or equipment.	
Seating Zone	Low	Strict social distancing measures will be implemented – visitors will be directed to specific safe zones and required to	

		stay in their allocated seat. Any breach of this direction could result in visitors being removed from the premises.	
Seat Cleansing	Low	Fixed plastic seats in the stadium will be used and restricted visitor numbers will ensure that seats are not used more than once in any four-week period. Seats used will be identified and sanitised following use.	
Toilets	High	Toilets will remain closed and out-of-bounds to all visitors.	
Indoor areas	Medium	Indoor areas will remain closed and out-of-bounds to all visitors.	
Contact with other staff or contractors working on the premises	Low	All staff and contractors visiting the premises will be following social distancing measures and the 'Open Spaces' zones will be carefully selected to avoid the risk of any close contact.	If visitor numbers increase continue to monitor.
Personal property and litter	Medium	All visitors will be instructed to keep personal property with them at all times and to remove any litter when leaving the premises.	Litter collection or bins provided using PPE.
Leaving the premises	Low	Staff will regularly patrol the 'Open Spaces' zone and visitors will be escorted to the exit point by a member of staff.
