The Club receives a high volume of requests from supporters to acknowledge the passing of loved ones and there are various ways in which this can be marked, including matchday announcements via the stadium PA and an annual feature marking the loss of Imps fans and family members in a special matchday programme.

Whilst we endeavour to accommodate family requests, it is Club policy that a minute's applause or silence and the wearing of black armbands is strictly reserved for Club Officials, Former Players and those directed by the FA and EFL.

However, the Club has recently introduced a Memorial Wall at LNER Stadium where bricks can be engraved as a lasting reminder of Imps supporters who have passed away.
